- **Course help:** In the event that I need help, I will post my request for support in the relevant forums and/or ask questions during the scheduled webinar sessions.
- **Copyright:** I commit to releasing my course work under a Free Cultural Works approved licence (CC-BY or CC-BY-SA) and adhere to all legal requirements for attributing reused and / or remixed OER in my learning pathway.

The course facilitator(s) will provide free access and support for learners who qualify to participate in the course and agree to the following commitments under this learning contract:

- **Acceptance portfolios:** Review and communicate acceptance into the course within one week of submission of the acceptance portfolio.
- **Learner support:** Respond to individual learner queries posted publicly in the course forums and other interaction technologies within one working day (taking international time zone differences of the facilitators into account).
- **Synchronous webinar sessions:** Agree to schedule a minimum of three webinar sessions and publish recordings of these sessions online for students unable to attend the synchronous session.
- **Design mentorship:** Where appropriate, share relevant experience in the design and development of open courses including support to fix Mediawiki syntax errors.
- **Technology support:** Provide free access to online software services including Mediawiki, Discourse forums and the Mastodon social media site. Participants will also be provided free hosting of two WordPress sites (for the duration of the course) with instructions on how to create backups of data in the event that the student wishes to set up a personal blog site on an alternate service after the course.
- **Assessment:** Assess badge submissions within 2 working days and, in cases where the participant has not met the minimum requirements, allow one resubmission with feedback on what is required to meet the minimum requirements.
